MINUTES OF THE 9/28/09 CLUB MEETING

- 1) ATTENDANCE – fourteen members and a guest, Ms. Kathy Spitale, “PrimeTime” Programs.
- 2) SECRETARY’S REPORT – minutes of previous meeting accepted.
- 3) TREASURER’S REPORT – reported at 9/14 meeting
- 4) MEALS ON WHEELS – Lion Pete Procaccio summarized the Stark-Wayne Meals on Wheels Program that was discussed at the last Zone meeting. A proposal was accepted to look into the program further and see how the Hartville Lions Club might get involved as a service project.
- 5) LAKE ROTARY CLUB – They proposed a joint fundraiser when King Lion Dave Rennels met with them recently. The sentiment among our club was that we might best cooperate with Rotary on an individual basis.
- 6) CLUB INCORPORATION – King Lion Dave repeated that Atty. John Morris has filed our Club’s documents with the Ohio Secretary of State. We expect to receive notification from them soon. There will be a one-time assessment to the membership of \$14/member, which will take place in October, to cover the \$525 attorney’s and filing fees.
- 7) PROGRAM: **“The PrimeTime Programs”** Ms. Kathy Spitale described the PrimeTime Program. Distinct from Aultman Hospital’s Prime Time Health Plan, this is a public relations outreach of Aultman. It is a social program aimed at adults age fifty and up, in which over 65,000 people from around the state are already enrolled. In addition to “perks” at Aultman Hospital, the program offers health and well-being seminars, concerts, golf and bowling leagues, classes in yoga, photography, ballroom dancing, personal computer, Pilates, *etc.*, as well as a wide variety of group tours. Membership is free, and members do not have to affiliate with Aultman Hospital. Some of our Lions are already members, and several more joined at our meeting.
